If you hold the position of department chair, we kindly ask you to seek a letter from the hospital administrative staff. These letters should highlight your professional achievements, leadership abilities, and dedication to professional excellence and expertise within your medical specialty. Furthermore, please share any prior mission experience you have undertaken, along with the number of cases performed during these missions. Your experience in providing surgical care in challenging environments will be highly valued.

We express our immense gratitude for considering FAJR as the platform to contribute your expertise. By submitting your application to our credentialing committee, you will have the opportunity to join our esteemed team and advance our mission of providing exceptional medical and surgical care.
